
Busselton Senior High School is a Registered Training Organisation school and offers a number of VET pathways to students. The school boasts a state of the art Trade Training Centre (TCC) at the school, and won the national VET in Schools Award in 2018. Busselton Senior High School has partnerships with a large number of employers, with close to 300 student placements in a year.

This year 52 students are currently enrolled in the Certificate II Building and Construction [pathway to trade] course, with the aim of getting participants into the building industry.

Harvey Bysher is one of the many students completing the course and is in the process of completing the practical component of the unit at WA Country Builders Busselton, working alongside our local Construction Supervisor, Ben Mattock.

Over the coming month, Harvey will be fortunate enough to progress into his desired area of trade, roof carpentry and will be working on site with a nominated WA Country Builders roof carpenter to gain insight into his field.
